# A type of belonging: occasional churchgoers, psychological type and the cathedral carol service

This presentation forms part of the research David is currently undertaking into those who come to Anglican worship, but infrequently. It will begin with an explanation of the theoretical model for church belonging that he has developed and successfully applied in a number of earlier studies. In order to study occasional churchgoing he has undertaken surveys of congregations on occasions when many are present and compared and contrasted these events with the attendees at regular Sunday worship. For this study he will draw on data from the cathedral Carol Service and make use of the theory of Psychological Type. He will reflect on the distinctive appeal of this service to the "thinking type", both men and women. He will conclude with the presentation of his emerging findings from cross-tabulation of the psychological types of the attendees with other factors studied in this survey.
